Past Continuous Forms

- + Subject + was / were + Verb + ing
- Subject + wasn't / weren't + Verb + ing
- ? was/were + Subject + Verb + ing ?
- ? Wh-word + was/were + Subject + Verb + ing ?

when + past simple (short action)

I was walking to school when I saw a friend of mine.

while + past continuous (long action)

My friend was watching something on his phone while he was waiting for the bus.
