- ***in + years*** (*in 2020*), ***seasons*** (*in summer*), ***months*** (*in December*), ***period of the day*** (*in the morning*)
- ***on + days of the week*** (*on Monday, on Tuesday, on Friday*)
- ***at + hours*** (*at 7 o'clock, at 9:30am, at midnight*)

Place

- ***at + location*** (*at school, at the supermarket, at home*)
- ***in + specific location*** (*in classroom 12, in the kitchen*)
- ***on + place*** (*on the desk, on the wall*)
