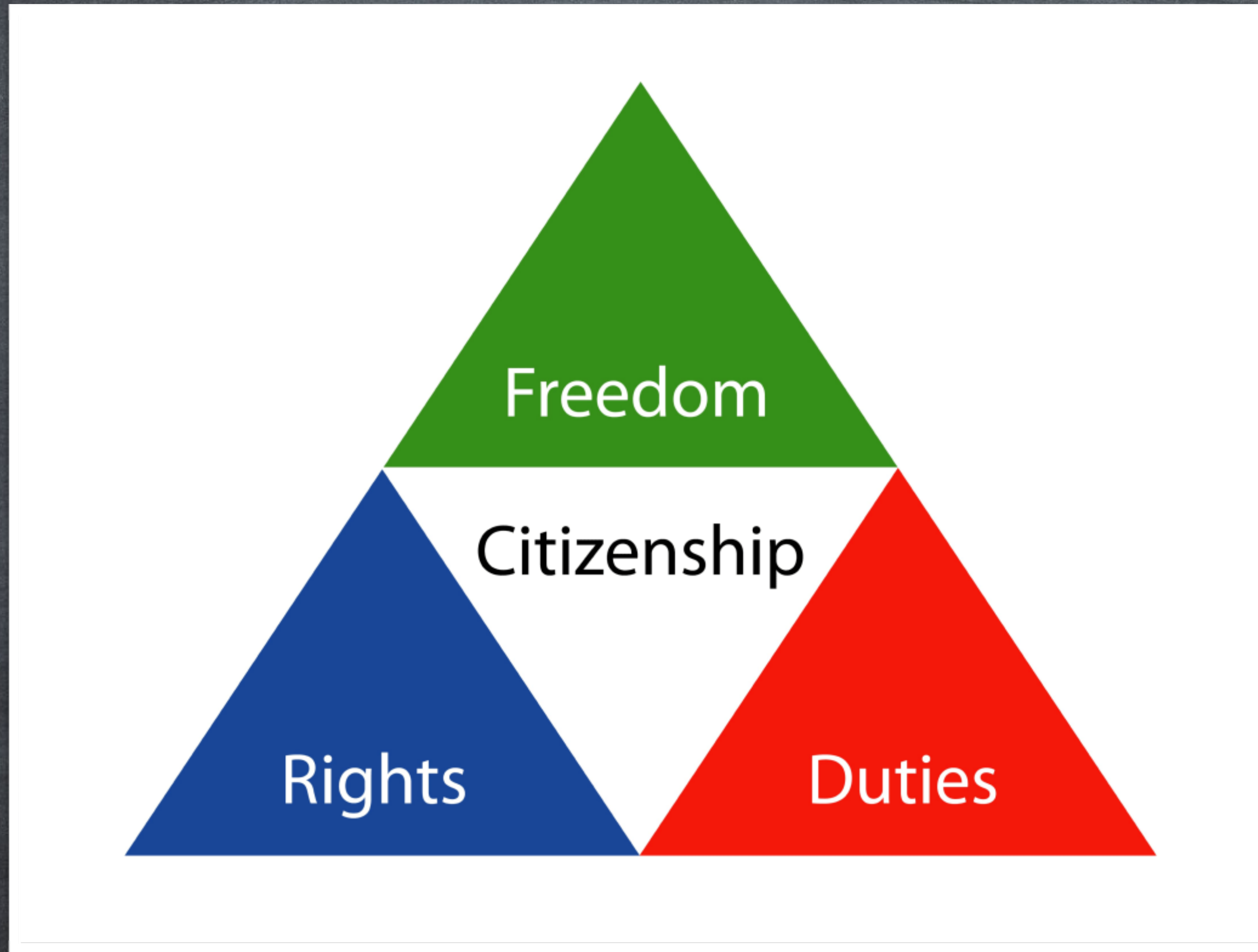

VOCABULARY: Citizenship

Citizenship:

The position or status of being a citizen of a particular country.

Community:

- 1. A group of people living in the same locality.**
- 2. The district or locality in which such a group lives.**

Active citizen:

A person who actively takes responsibility and initiative in areas of public concern in his community.

Civic values:

The beliefs people have about what is right and wrong and what is most important, which control their civic behavior.

A set of responsibilities that citizens have, such as: respecting laws, paying taxes and voting.

Volunteering/Community Service:

Work that people do to help other people without payment.

Cooperation:

The act of working together with someone.

Patriotism:
