- **Point of view (who tells the story)**
- **Character (who / what is in the story)**
- **Action (what happened)**



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Paragraph Structure

The topic sentence sets the Setting (time/place) + Point of view (who tells the story) + Character (who / what is in the story) + Action (what happened).

Supporting sentences are arranged in a chronological order and are connected through time expressions or adverbs of sequence.

The concluding sentence is generally an opinion about the experience/story.
