A: Whose pencil is this?

B: Oh, that's my pencil.

A: And whose notebooks are these?

B: They're Sara's.



GRAMMAR: Whose & Possessive ('s)

Singular: whose + Singular Noun + is + this/that ?

Plural: whose + Plural Noun + are + these/those ?

Possessive ('s): It's / They're + Proper Noun + possessive ('s)
