GRAMMAR: The Present Continuous

Present Continuous

am / is / are + verb + ing

- **I'm looking** for a city map.
- **He is visiting** London right now.



GRAMMAR: The Present Continuous

Affirmative

I'm visiting London.
You're visiting London.
He's visiting London.
She's visiting London.

We're visiting London.
You're visiting London.
They're visiting London.

Negative

I'm not visiting Paris.
You're not visiting Paris.
He's not visiting Paris.
She's not visiting Paris.

We're not visiting Paris.
You're not visiting Paris.
They're not visiting Paris.

GRAMMAR: The Present Continuous

Yes/No Questions	Answers
Are you visiting London?	Yes, I am . / No, I'm not .
Is he visiting London?	Yes, he is . / No, he isn't .
Is she visiting London?	Yes, she is . / No, she isn't .
Are they visiting London?	Yes, they are . / No, they aren't .

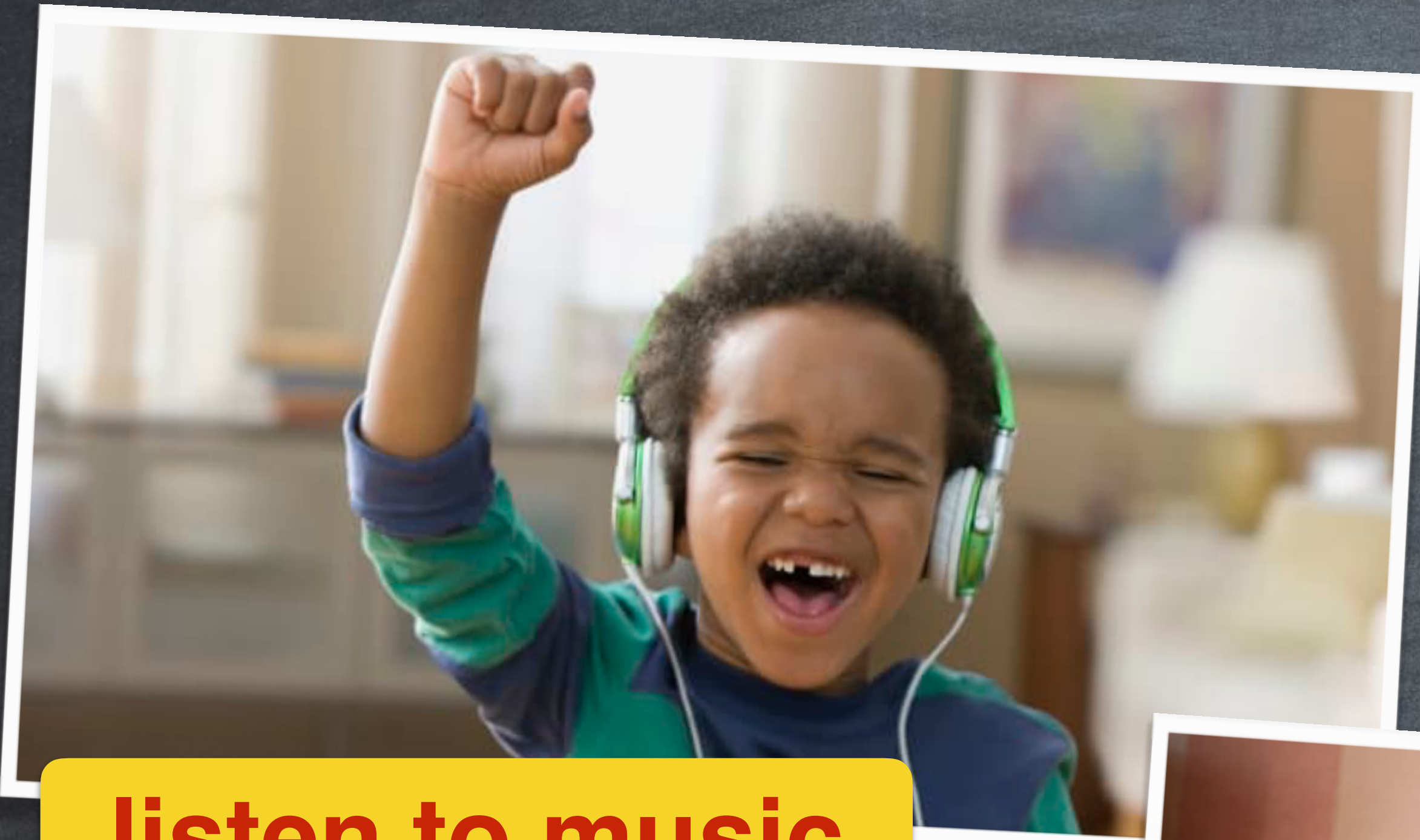
