Umm Kulthum was born in 1898 in a small Egyptian village near the Nile Delta. Her father was an imam and In the second the Quran and to sing by listening to her father. From a young age, she showed an exceptional singing talent. When she was 12, she joined her father's recital band. She dressed up as a boy. At the age of 16, she started learning old classical Arabic music. During the 1920s, she visited Cairo for several times and met different famous composers.



In 1923, she moved to Cairo and started her professional career. She collaborated with famous Arab composers like Mohamed El Qasbiji and Daoud Hosni. The poet Ahmed Amine wrote 137 songs for her. She recorded about 300 songs and performed in many Arab capital cities, and in the House of Opera in Paris. A typical Umm Kulthum concert consisted of a performance of 2 or 3 songs over a period of 3 to 4 hours. Her songs were 45 to 90 minutes long. Umm Kulthum died in December **1975.** Around 4 million people attended her funeral.




