"I'll **travel** to London next week."

"**Send** me your email address."

"**Are** you from Marrakech?"

"**Where are** you from?"

GRAMMAR: Reported Speech 2

Direct Speech	Reported Speech
"I'll travel to London next week."	He said that he would travel to London the following week.
"Send me your email address."	She told me to send her my email address.
"Are you from Marrakech?"	She asked me if I was from Marrakech.
"Where are you from?"	He asked me where I was from.

say + (that) + statement

Yes/No Questions



ask + if + Subject + Verb

Wh-Questions



ask + wh-word + Subject + Verb

Imperatives



tell + infinitive (to/not to + verb)
