- Smartphones **have enabled** people to find information instantly.
- Karima **has just bought** a new smartphone.
- I **have already watched** this movie on internet.
- He **hasn't fixed** his Wifi connection **yet**.
- **Have you ever used** Spotify? It's an amazing music App.

# GRAMMAR: The Present Perfect

## PRESENT PERFECT

PAST

PRESENT

FUTURE

Internet **has changed** our way of living.

Karima **has just bought** a new smartphone.

Use the present perfect to talk about:

- **unfinished actions** that started in the past and continue to the present.
- **finished actions** related to the present.

# GRAMMAR: The Present Perfect

**have (not) + past participle**

**Internet has changed our way of living.**

- +** **have / has + past participle**
- **haven't / hasn't + past participle**
- ?** **have / has + subject + past participle**

**have + just / already / + past participle**

- Karima has just bought a new smartphone.**
- I have already watched this movie.**

# GRAMMAR: The Present Perfect

**yet & ever**

- **He hasn't fixed his Wifi connection yet.**
- **Have you ever used Spotify?**

- **haven't / hasn't + past participle + yet**
- ? **have / has + subject + ever + past participle**

<b>I have watched</b> <b>You have watched</b> <b>He has watched</b> <b>She has watched</b> <b>It has watched</b> <b>We have watched</b> <b>You have watched</b> <b>They have watched</b>	<b>I haven't watched</b> <b>You haven't watched</b> <b>He hasn't watched</b> <b>She hasn't watched</b> <b>It hasn't watched</b> <b>We haven't watched</b> <b>You haven't watched</b> <b>They haven't watched</b>	<b>Have you ever watched...?</b>  <b>Has he/she ever watched to...?</b>  <b>Have they ever watched...?</b>
