- + have / has + past participle
- haven't / hasn't + past participle
- ? have / has + subject + past participle

have + just / already / + past participle

- I have already watched this movie.

## yet & ever

- · He hasn't fixed his Wifi connection yet.
- Have you ever used Spotify?

- haven't / hasn't + past participle + yet
- have / has + subject + ever + past participle
