**B:** Yes, I did. I found it *boring*.

**A:** Actually, many people found it *interesting*.



**A:** Have you even been to the new amusement park?

**B:** Yes. I went there with some friends last month. We were really *fascinated* by the new attractions.

# WORD-FORMATION: Participle Adjectives

## Participle Adjectives

**Verb+ed**

**feel + verb+ed**

**Example: I feel *bored*.**

**Verb+ing**

**someone/something is +  
verb+ing**

**Example: This movie is *boring*.**

Adjectives with <b>-ed</b>	Adjectives with <b>-ing</b>
<b>interested</b>	<b>interesting</b>
<b>amused</b>	<b>amusing</b>
<b>fascinated</b>	<b>fascinating</b>
<b>satisfied</b>	<b>satisfying</b>
<b>relaxed</b>	<b>relaxing</b>
<b>attracted</b>	<b>attracting</b>

## Negative Emotions

Adjectives with <b>-ed</b>	Adjectives with <b>-ing</b>
<b>bored</b>	<b>boring</b>
<b>shocked</b>	<b>shocking</b>
<b>embarrassed</b>	<b>embarrassing</b>
<b>annoyed</b>	<b>annoying</b>
<b>disappointed</b>	<b>disappointing</b>
<b>worried</b>	<b>worrying</b>




**A:** *What do you think about strategy video games?*
