

GRAMMAR: The Future

A: Do you have any plans for this evening?

B: Yes, I do. I'm going to do my homework. After that, I'm going to watch my favorite TV series.



A: What are you going to do next weekend?

B: I'm not sure. I think I'll go hiking with some friends.

GRAMMAR: The Future Plan

Future plan (be going to + verb)

Affirmative forms

I am going to play soccer tomorrow.

You are going to play soccer this afternoon.

He / she is going to play soccer next weekend.

We / you / they are going to play soccer next week.

GRAMMAR: The Future Plan

Future plan (be + not + going to + verb)

Negative Forms

I am not going to play video games this afternoon.

You are not going to play video games tomorrow.

He / she is not going to play video games next weekend.

We / you / they are not going to play video games today.

GRAMMAR: The Future Simple

Future Simple (will + verb)

Affirmative forms

I **will watch** a movie tonight.

You **will watch** a movie tomorrow.

He / she **will watch** a movie this weekend.

We / you / they **will watch** a movie next week.

I will = I'll

GRAMMAR: The Future Simple

Future Simple (will not + verb)

Negative Forms

I **will not watch** the news tonight.

You **will not watch** the news tomorrow.

He / she **will not watch** the news next weekend.

We / you / they **will not watch** the news this evening.

will not = won't
