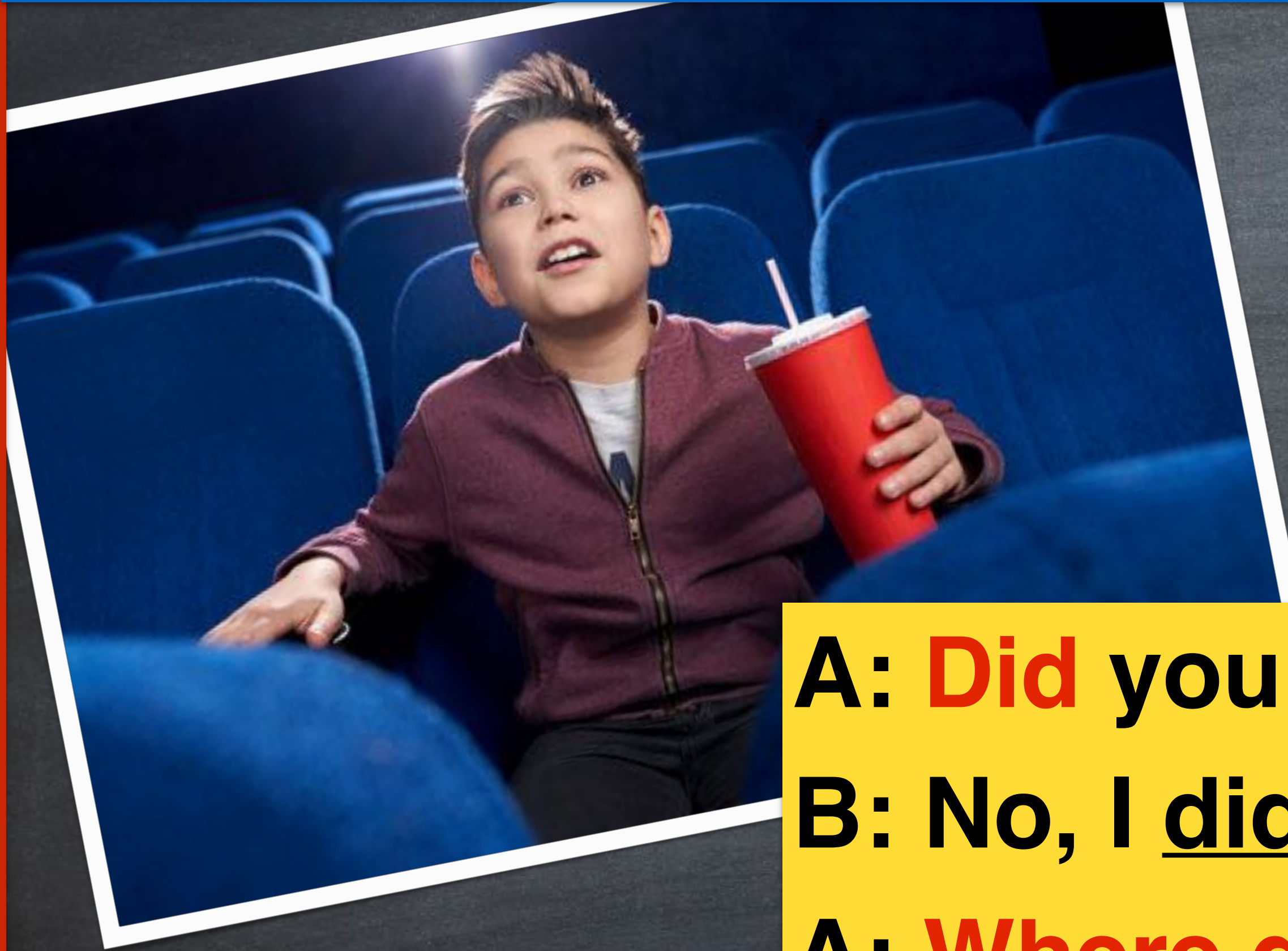


GRAMMAR: Simple Past Questions with “did”



A: **Did** you **go** to the theater last Sunday?

B: No, I didn't.

A: **Where did** you **go**?

B: I went to the movies.

A: **Did** you **watch** the new action movie?

B: Yes, I did. It was terrific.

GRAMMAR: Simple Past Questions with “did”

Did you go to the theater last Sunday?

Yes/no questions = did + subject + verb

Where did you go?

Wh-questions = wh-word + did + subject + verb

Wh-words = what, where, how, who, when, why
